# Detailed Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Cut and label all lumber.

Step 2: Build the upper frame.

Step 3: Attach the legs.

Step 4: Install the lower shelf frame.

Step 5: Install shelf and top panels.

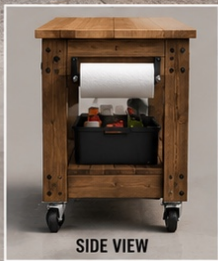
Step 6: Mount locking casters.

Step 7: Sand all surfaces smooth.

Step 8: Apply exterior finish.

Step 9: Install accessories and place beside your Blackstone griddle.
